GAME NOTES

- **ROUGH WATERS:** After dropping three games in a row to the Milwaukee Admirals from Jan. 10-14, the Rockford IceHogs are at risk of losing four straight to the Admirals for the first time since the club dropped five in a row from Jan. 7 March 23, 2018. The last time Milwaukee took three straight against the IceHogs prior to the current stretch was from March 22-27 of 2019.
- **DAVID & GOLIATH:** Wednesday's battle will see the league's worst power play faceoff against the league's second-best power play. Rockford's 10.3% success rate on the man-advantage is dead last in the American Hockey League. Meanwhile, Milwaukee's 24.6% on the power play is second-best in the league behind the Stockton Heat (25.5%).
- NO MORE SCORE: Rockford's shutout losses Monday against Belleville and Wednesday against Texas marks the first time since the 2016-17 season that the IceHogs have been held scoreless in back-to-back contests. The previous instance occurred from March 25-28 of 2017 when Rockford fell 0-4 to Grand Rapids and 0-4 to Iowa.
- **TOMMY BOY:** Matt Tomkins kicked away 30 of 31 shots in the Ice-Hogs' loss Wednesday and then signed a two-year, two-way contract with the Blackhawks on Thursday that carries an AAV of \$700,000 and runs through the 2020-21 season. Tomkins is 5-4 with the IceHogs in the 2019-20 season and leads the team in both goals-against average (2.45) and save percentage (.916).
- GOTTA CATCH 'EM ALL: Wednesday's loss to the Stars was the IceHogs' first loss of the season when allowing just one goal. Rockford now moves to 7-1 on the season when holding teams to a single tally.

The Admirals host the IceHogs Friday as the top team in the entire AHL with 64 points through 43 contests. Milwaukee has won five of its last six games, including three straight against Rockford from Jan. 10-14 in which they outscored the Hogs 8-2. The club is led by perhaps the hottest goaltending tandem in the league, with Troy Grosenick boasting a 15-4-2 record, 2.13 GAA and .925 SV% while Connor Ingram holds a 14-4-4 record, 2.04 GAA and .929 SV%.
