GAME NOTES

- **DEJA-VU:** The Rockford IceHogs enter Tuesday's contest against the Grand Rapids Griffins just two points outside of a playoff spot behind the Griffins and Chicago Wolves, who are tied for third in the Central Division standings. The IceHogs currently hold a record of 4-3-0-0 against the Griffins in 2019-20. Last year, the IceHogs were also 4-3-0-0 against the Griffins and went on to win all three remaining contests between the two teams.
- THE RIGHT TRACK: Saturday's 4-1 victory over the Cleveland Monsters marks the first time the IceHogs have won five out of their previous six games since Nov. 29-Dec. 10.
- OH MY COSH: Ian McCoshen netted his first goal of the season on Saturday before adding an empty-netter to note the first multi-goal game of his professional career. It was the first time McCoshen had lit the lamp since Feb. 23, 2019, when he scored for the Florida Panthers against the Los Angeles Kings.
- **DYL PICKLE:** Dylan Sikura's power-play goal in Saturday's win over the Cleveland Monsters increases his point streak to a career-high 10 games in which he's deposited four goals and tossed nine assists. Not only is the streak the longest by any IceHog this season, but the stretch eclipses Sikura's previous career-high six-game point streak he set from Feb. 2-April 4 of 2019 in which he contributed seven points (3g, 4a).


