GAME NOTES

- LAST CHANCE: The Rockford IceHogs face off against the Cleveland Monsters for the last time in 2019-20 on Saturday and are in danger of going winless in a season against the Monsters for the first time since the 2011-12 campaign when the Hogs went 0-4-0-0 against the then Lake Erie Monsters. Rockford is 0-3-0-0 so far this season after dropping a two-game series in Cleveland on Oct. 25-26 and a home contest on Dec. 21.
- THE RIGHT TRACK: Thursday's 5-2 victory against the Manitoba Moose marks the first time the IceHogs have won four out of their previous five games since Dec. 10-20.
- ...I CAN DO BETTER: Lucas Carlsson assisted on a pair of goals in Thursday's 5-2 win over the Moose to extend his assist streak to five games in which he's set up seven goals. The stretch marks the longest point-streak of his professional career and would be the longest assist streak by any IceHog this season, however, Dylan Sikura's assist Thursday pushed his own assist streak to six games in which he's earned six assists.
- THE RIGHT TRACK: After going 0-for-14 on the power play across five games from Jan. 15-22 and falling to 31st in the AHL in power play rankings, the IceHogs have now netted eight power-play goals across their last eight matchups, going 8-for-36 (22.2%) in that span and jumping to 29th in the league with a success rate of 12.3% on the season.
